

Donald Sulzen is one of the few pianists who have attained highest international recognition in two realms of classical music. Not only is he a collaborator with some of the worlds most celebrated singers, such as *Anna Caterina Antonacci, Laura Aikin, Doris Soffel, Thomas E. Bauer, Thomas Cooley* and *James Taylor*, but is also the pianist of the renowned *Munich Piano Trio*. His extensive concert activity includes tours through the most prestigious recital halls of Europe, the USA, South America and Japan. Numerous recordings for radio and television, as well as thirty CD productions document the high artistic level of this pianist.

After teaching for several years at the *Hochschule für Musik und darstellende Kunst "Mozarteum"* in Salzburg, he accepted a professorship for the instruction of song duos at the *Hochschule für Musik und Theater* in Munich, where he presently resides. Donald Sulzen's passion to combine the musicians of his trio with his vocal artists is revealed through unique CD recordings involving works of Joseph Haydn, Alberto Ginastera, Ned Rorem and Astor Piazzolla.
